#### **A YIELDED FAITH**

We are introduced to an unlikely character to model a Yielded Faith, but this Gentile centurion understood more about a faith that pleases God than many of the religious people of that day or even today. Luke 7 recounts the story of this centurion who realized he needed Jesus's healing touch to save his faithful servant. He also realized that he hadn't done anything to deserve Jesus's time. As Jesus drew near the centurion again showed his faith by demonstrating his unworthiness to even speak to Jesus. This bold expression of faith amazed Jesus and led to "I have not found so great a faith even in Israel." (vs.9) The centurion's yielded faith was a ready faith that withstood the trials of his chaotic season.
